<u>Early Help</u>

Early Help is the support we offer to potentially vulnerable children, young people and their families.

The purpose of Early Help is to put in the right support at the right time so that problems are less likely to escalate to a point where the child becomes vulnerable or in need. Early Help is sustainable so that problems are less likely to re-occur.

Early Help does not always mean early years. While research does show that most impact can be made in those crucial first few years of a child's life, Early Help can be needed and put in place at any time and at any age. All children, young people and families in Warwickshire are entitled to receive Early Help. This means offering information, advice, quidance, and support to families as soon as a concern emerges, or seems likely to emerge.

If you feel that you or your family could benefit from Early Help, please see us at the office and we will be happy to put the right support in place.

Here are some ideas you could try with your child this month...

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This month's seasonal recipe to try at home...

Mother's Day Banana Oat Pancakes



Ingredients

- 125ml oat milk
- 2 eggs, seperated
- 1 small banana
- 100g rolled oats
- 2 tsp baking powder
- Few drops vanilla extract
- Oil spray
- Low fat yogurt and fruit to top



Method

- 1. Put the oat milk, egg yolks, banana, oats, baking powder and vanilla in a blender and process to as smooth a mixture as you can get.
- 2. Whisk the eggs whites until they hold stiff peaks.
- 3. Whisk 1-2 tbsp of the whites into the batter, then fold in the rest.
- 4. Heat a non-stick pan over a medium heat and spray with a little oil
- 5. Pour about 2 tbsp of batter into the pan and cook for 1-2 mins, until the base sets and bubbles appear all over the top.
- 6. Flip and cook the other side for a minute.
- 7. Repeat in batches, making sure the top looks dryish before attempting the flip, or the centre will collapse.
- 8. Serve with fruit and yoqurt for a perfect breakfast in bed!
